



# NATIONAL AEROLYMPICS - 2019

## THEME: INDIAN SPACE EXPLORATIONS

Over the years, right from Aryabhata to Gaganyaan, India's space research and exploration has allowed the nation to move into the world of high technology in both Defence applications and Research & Development. As our First PM Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru ji said, The Children of today will make India of tomorrow, the way we bring them up will determine the future of the country. This event will motivate children to explore, learn and to choose space technology as their dream career opportunity.

### THE AIM

- To create awareness about India's Aerospace programme
- Enable students to collect, collate, sift, arrange and present information
- Motivate participants to join the aviation industry as Engineers, Scientists and Designers

### PHASE-1

- A team of 3 students from classes IX-XII of any stream can participate as a group and more than one team can be fielded from a school.
- Each team should submit Project Report on the above theme between 20 to 40 pages (Between cover to cover) on A-4 size paper (Font - Aerial Regular, Size - 11).
- The report can include photographs, diagrams, sketches and tables in addition to text. It should cover various aspects concerning developments in the field.
- The Project Report should reach the Hon.Secretary, AeSI bangalore latest by 20th Dec 2018 along with Team Data form and a demand draft of Rs 2000/- of any bank in favour of 'The Aeronautical society of India, Bangalore Branch at the following address,

### PHASE-2

- Best 20 teams from all over India will be selected by a panel on the basis of the project reports.
- These best teams will participate in a 3 day 'National Aerolympics-2019' in Bangalore from 18-20th Jan 2019. Team will travel on their own expenditure.
- Boarding & lodging in Bangalore will be provided by Aeronautical Society of India.
- During the Olympiad, there will be competitive events on three groups namely individual, school team & group activities

- Encourage your beloved students to Collect, Collate data and to prepare report by their own efforts only.
- Last date for Receipt of Report at AeSI office 20-12-2018
- Only one best team form one school will be selected if multiple teams are participating from same school.
- Previous year participants are not allowed to participate, only fresh teams from each school will be allowed.
- The selected teams from Phase 1 need to submit Phase 2 project report.
